

**ALGER COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION
MAILBOX POLICY**

The snow plow operators' visibility is restricted due to plowing operations, stormy conditions, snow accumulation, etc., which makes it very difficult for them to see unmarked mail boxes.

The Alger County Road Commission requests the cooperation of residents living along county roads and streets to have their mailbox locations marked with a wooden pole, approximately 1.5" in diameter and of sufficient length that it will extend at least three feet above the mailbox at all times.

The Road Commission will only repair mail boxes that comply with highway regulations and have been properly marked when damaged as a result of being struck by a snow plow unit. In the event the damage is so severe that the existing box is beyond repair, it will be replaced with a metal box, the size and style of which shall be at the discretion of the Road Commission. Unmarked mailboxes that are damaged and those that have been damaged by snow thrown by the plows will not be repaired/replaced.
