

**POLICY FOR
NON-AUTHORIZED ENCROACHMENT IN RIGHT OF WAYS**

No objects, structures, fences, barriers, materials, obstacles, refuse, or personal property may be placed or erected in a right of way under the control jurisdiction, or legally maintained by the Alger County Road Commission without the express written permission of a duly authorized agent or designee of the Alger County Road Commission.

After thirty 30 days written notice to remove the property, any non-permitted items found within a right of way area described above shall be subject to removal, at the expense of the responsible party and or property owner.

Failure to comply with said notice shall subject the responsible party to legal proceedings and all liability associated with allowing a hazard and or encroachment within the right of way to continue.

All costs of prosecution, legal expenses, related damages and removal costs will be sought against the property owner and or offending party in all instances of non-compliance.
