

ALGER COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION

POLICY FOR

SEASONAL ROAD PLOWING

This policy is adopted by authority conferred by section 5a of ACT 51 of the public Acts of 1951, as amended.

All roads on the Seasonal Road System will not be plowed during the months of November through April except as hereinafter provided:

A seasonal road or a portion of a seasonal road will be plowed:

- a. By permit, provided that the Alger County Road Commission is named as an additional insured party on a liability insurance policy. Coverage shall not be less than one million dollars. A standard permit fee for work within the right-of-way shall apply. The Alger County Road Commission reserves the right to deny any request if it is determined to be detrimental to the roadway by the Engineer/Manager.

If it is determined by the Engineer/Manager, in his sole discretion, that before said plowing can be performed, improvements are required or post-use repair may be necessary, the applicant applying for the plowing of the road shall deposit, by way of performance bond, or other acceptable means, their share of the estimated/potential costs.

- b. By the Alger County Road Commission, if necessary to accommodate winter road construction or maintenance.
- c. By the Alger County Road Commission, if necessary to accommodate an emergency response involving a potentially life threatening situation.
- d. By the Alger County Road Commission, if requested by a governmental agency, in an emergency situation, at the discretion of the Engineer/Manager.
