### ENGINEER/MANAGER'S REPORT

## **MDOT** Maintenance Work:

All crews continue to mow roadsides and clear-vision areas along State Highways.

State Bridge Bundling for Woodland Road Bridge and Kivamaki Road Bridge:

The planning process continues for both structures, with construction delayed until funds become available. Kivamaki Bridge is moving through the State Historic Preservation Office review process.

## H-58 over the Sucker River Bridge:

The project will be re-bid in early fall 2024, with a completion date of November 1, 2025.

## Chapel Road Construction Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) Grant:

Bacco Construction has resumed work. The stump removal, brushing, and topsoil stripping began on July 29<sup>th</sup>. Compacting of fill material and finished gravel is scheduled to begin on August 13<sup>th</sup>. Traffic will be maintained at all times with signing and flag-persons. The project completion date is September 27<sup>th</sup>.

## 2024 H-58 Project (Miners Castle Road to 1.5 miles East):

The project has been awarded to Payne & Dolan, Inc. Construction is delayed significantly, due to the contractor's schedule. Payne & Dolan intends to mobilize to the project on September 9<sup>th</sup>. Paying is planned for September 16<sup>th</sup>.

## Rapid River Truck Trail Pulverizing and Paving Bids:

Bacco Construction has paving scheduled for August 12<sup>th</sup>. The existing pavement was pulverized on July 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>. Road Commission crews will be adding gravel, compacting and fine-grading during the week of July 29<sup>th</sup>. The intersection area of Crossover Road will be reconstructed, during the week of August 5<sup>th</sup>.

## 2025 H-58 Project (Rosemund Road to 1.75 miles West):

The design process is COMPLETE. The MDOT Agreement will be available for Board approval, following the October fiscal year. I anticipate a bid letting in January of 2025.
