ENGINEER/MANAGER'S REPORT

MDOT Maintenance Work:

All crews continue to mow roadsides and clear-vision areas along State Highways. Following the October 1st MDOT fiscal year, we will plan to mow and brush the County road system.

State Bridge Bundling for Woodland Road Bridge and Kivamaki Road Bridge:

The planning process continues for both structures, with construction delayed until funds become available. Kivamaki Bridge is moving through the State Historic Preservation Office review process.

H-58 over the Sucker River Bridge:

The project will be re-bid in early fall 2024, with a completion date of November 1, 2025.

Chapel Road Construction Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) Grant:

Bacco Construction has completed nearly half of the project length with new roadbed and gravel surface. The project completion date is September 27th.

2024 H-58 Project (Miners Castle Road to 1.5 miles East):

The project has been awarded to Payne & Dolan, Inc. Construction is delayed significantly, due to the contractor's schedule. Payne & Dolan intends to mobilize to the project on September 9th. Paving is planned for September 16th.

Rapid River Truck Trail Pulverizing and Paving Bids:

The project is COMPLETE.

2025 H-58 Project (Rosemund Road to 1.75 miles West):

The design process is COMPLETE. The MDOT Agreement will be available for Board approval, following the October fiscal year. I anticipate a bid letting in January of 2025.

2025 Tandem Truck Bids:

The plow trucks have been advertised, with a due date of September 11th.

Superior Central School Track Grading:

The project is COMPLETE.

Johnson Lane Bridge:

The fabrication is complete. The EGLE (formerly MDEQ) permit was approved on August 27th. We will strategize to begin work on September 3rd.

Munising Township 2025 Agreement:

I have prepared and submitted the Agreement for 2025 projects to the Township. <u>I recommend the Road Commission Board approves this agreement and authorize the Finance Director and Engineer-Manager to sign.</u>

AuTrain Township 2025 Agreement:
