MDOT Maintenance Work:

We are in winter maintenance now. Night shift is in effect. Salt deliveries have been received.

State Bridge Bundling Options for Woodland Road Bridge and Kivamaki Road Bridge:

The planning process continues for both structures, with construction delayed beyond 2023. Correspondence is included with this meeting.

H-58 over the Sucker River Bridge:

Preliminary plans include a 40-foot span precast concrete arch bridge structure. Final plans and advertisement will likely occur in the spring of 2024.

Chapel Road Construction Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) Grant:

Bacco Construction has completed clearing this fall. Construction will begin, after weight restrictions are removed in 2024.

Rapid River Truck Trail Pavement Reconstruction 2024:

Paving bids will be advertised in February of 2024.

William Hill Road and Sandy Lane (Burt Township Projects):

The project is COMPLETE.

Rock RiverTownship 2024 Project Agreement:

The Township has indicated that they would like to proceed with two sections of gravel road improvements. <u>I recommend that the Road Commission approves the Agreement and authorizes the Engineer-Manager and Finance Director to sign.</u>

Luce County Road 407 Detour and Haul Route via H-58:

The damaged pavement, on H-58, has been repaired by Luce County's contractor.

Harju Road Pit Purchase Offer:

As discussed in the October 16th Board Meeting, Mr. Forehand, of Manulife investments, advised me that it would best to first pursue the Harju Road (36 +/- acres), and that the last transaction that was approved by the public pension fund was \$2,200 per acre. He explained that an offer of \$2,200 would be considered a reasonable offer and that I must follow the Guidelines for Unsolicited Offers. Action on this item was tabled, during the October 16th Regular Board meeting. I was directed to research zoning and also the cost to extract the parcel from Commercial Forest Act (CFA) designation. A zoning map has been included in each board packet and our Finance Director will provide information, during the November 6th meeting related to our last CFA removal and the Harju Road parcel specifically. Irecommend that the Road Commission authorizes the Engineer-Manager to follow the Guidelines to submit a written offer for the \$2,200 per acre immediately.

2024 H-58 Project (Miners Castle Road to 1.5 miles East):

I have completed design of this 2024 Federal Aid project. It is my goal to secure a February 2024 bid letting for this project. An MDOT Agreement is expected, within the next 60-days.

AuTrain Pit Gravel Crushing Bids 2024:

I have advertised for bids to crush 22A specification gravel in 2024. We will need 6,500 tons for the Rapid River Truck Trail project in 2024, as well as 2,800 for our contracted work in Burt Township. We must be prepared for future work in Munising Township for 2025. Sealed bids will be received on November 22, 2023 at 1:00 pm for 25,000 tons of material.

Brian Menghini had asked about placing reflector strips on the stop signs on H-44 intersecting the Eben-Trenary Rd. Lindbeck will have this done.
